Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc, 2018, Domaine de Beurenard, Rhone Valley, France <i>An excellent example of white Châteauneuf: gently aromatic, with notes of pears, apricots, hawthorn and fennel, then round and textured in the mouth, with a seam of minerality providing focus. Gewürztraminer, 2017, Nussbaumer, Cantina Tramin, Alto Adige, Italy <i>An elegant wine showing a kaleidoscope of aromas. Rose petal and lily blossom combine with ripe exotic yellow fruits such as cantaloupe, mango, passion fruit and lychee, all enveloped by spicy notes of ginger, cinnamon and nutmeg.
